



Congregation Shalom is a reform congregation with a full time Rabbi. Rabbi Shoshana Perry has been with us since 1998.

<u>Shabbat Services:</u> We offer Tot Shabbats (at 6:15 p.m.), Family Friday night services (at 7:00 p.m.) and adult evening services (at both 8:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.). Torah Study is held on Saturday or Sunday mornings. Bar/Bat Mitzvahs are conducted during Saturday morning services. Check the newsletter calendar to see which type of service is being held on a particular Shabbat.

Oneg after Shabbat services is hosted by our temple families. Each temple family, after their first year membership, is required to host one to two onegs each year.

<u>Social activities</u> are numerous at Congregation Shalom. We have an active Youth Group, Brotherhood, and Sisterhood. Additionally, there is an Annual Progressive Dinner, Book Club, and a Social Committee that plans various programs during the year.

We have many <u>Committees</u>, including Caring (helping those in need within our congregation), Social Action (helping those in need in our community), and Adult Education (providing interesting programs), at Congregation Shalom. Being active on a committee is a great way to be involved in our congregation and make new friends.

Our <u>School</u> includes preschool (ages 3 & 4) through high school seniors. Participation in the preschool, which meets monthly, does not require membership. Temple membership is required for grades kindergarten on up. Weekly religious school starts in kindergarten; Hebrew class is added in 3rd grade. We require 5 years in the Hebrew school to complete bar/bat mitzvah.
