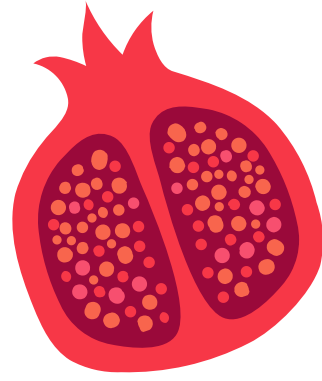

OCTOBER 12

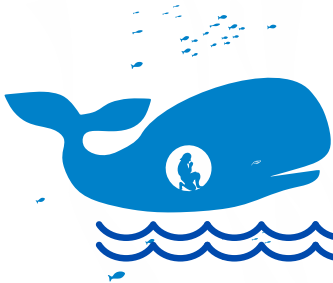
YOM KIPPUR / SHABBAT FAMILY SERVICE 9:00AM TO 10:00AM

YIZKOR SERVICE 4:00PM TO 5:00PM

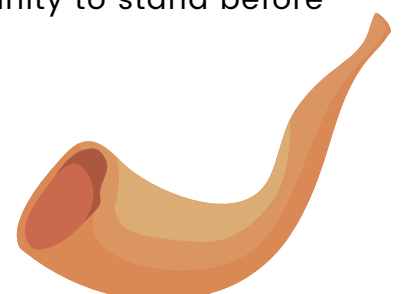
In addition to honoring the memories of our loved ones we will say special prayers of remembrance for those lost on October 7th and after.
